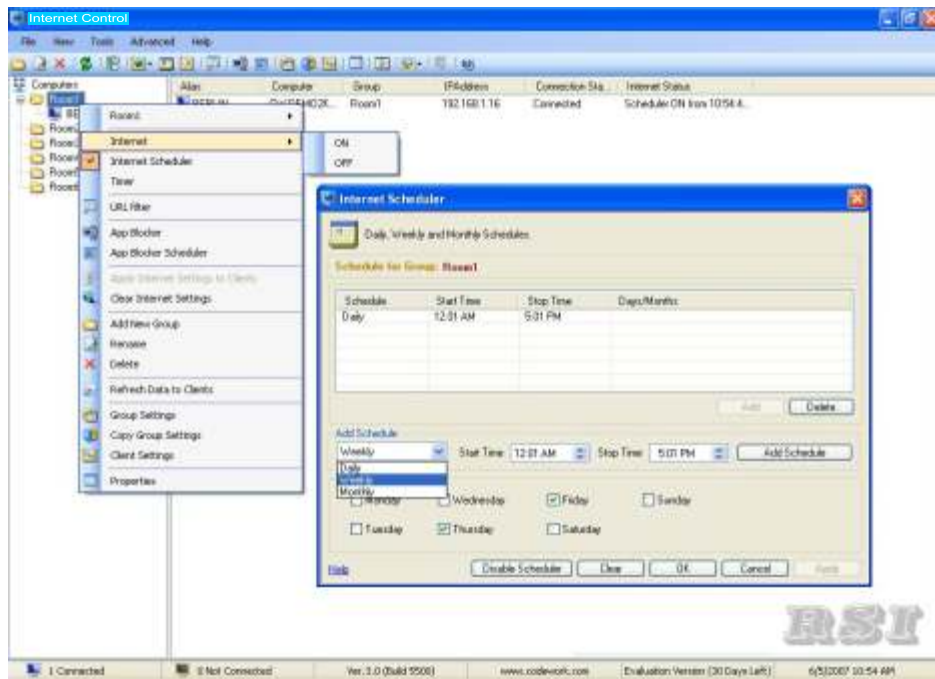

Statistics from various respected sources indicate a critical need for internet control measures. International Data Corporation estimated that 30% to 40% of employee Internet use isn't work related. Nielsen/NetRatings reported 92% of online stock trading occurs from the workplace during work hours and 46% of online holiday shopping takes place at work. Another shocking statistic from SexTracker states that 70% of all Web traffic to Internet pornography sites occurs between 9 am and 5 pm. Real cost loss estimates range from 1.75 billion to well over 2.5 billion a year.

SHADOW^{IC} enables administrators to set limits on employee access to time-wasting web activities while still permitting them to reach the sites they need to conduct business. Policies can be defined by user or groups of users or PCs and scheduled for specific hours.
